

Should I take the Math placement exam?

Are you considering taking Math during your first year at Utah State?

(Typically students majoring in Business, Engineering, Elementary Education, and Science are encouraged to begin math as soon as possible).

Don't take the placement test as it is only good for one year.

The placement test is available year-round in the Math department.

Yes

Within the past year* did you:

- ♦ Receive 23 or higher on the ACT?
- or
- ♦ Receive 540 or higher on the SAT?
- or
- ♦ Pass the AP Calculus AB test with a score of 3 or higher?
- or
- ♦ Receive a grade of C- or higher in Math 1050 concurrent enrollment?

***To enroll in math during a given semester, you must meet the prerequisite after the deadline for that semester:**

Fall Semester: August 15 of the previous year

Spring Semester: January 1 of the previous year

Summer Semester: June 1 of the previous year

You have two options:

- ♦ You can take the beginning MATH 0900 (Elements of Algebra) class without taking the placement test
- or
- ♦ You can take the Math Placement Test to see if you can place into a higher math class.
